A Light Shining in Darkness

Elder Victim Ministry has



helped over 5,000 elders prevail over the trauma of abuse, neglect, exploitation and other crimes, providing individualized recovery services. We visit homes, provide crisis counseling and spiritual advocacy, cobuild safety plans, accompany victims at

court, assist with emergency repairs, guide scam and identity theft recovery and facilitate mediation.



A Felony Offense

The elder who escaped deprivation,

financial exploitation, psychological intimidation and severe physical abuse in 2014 saw legal and financial recovery through the justice system, healing and trauma support through social and health services, and an animal rescue and shelter from the humane society. Elder Victim Ministry staff and volunteers coordinated services, provided emergency financial assistance and have kept in touch with the victim to avoid re-victimization.

One victim at a time...

We scan police reports weekly and receive partner referrals on potential cases of abuse. Suspected cases of elder neglect, financial exploitation, physical or sexual abuse or abandonment are reported to Adult Protective Services. After an APS investigation, Elder Victim Ministry staff and volunteers follow up on cases to provide emergency financial assistance, safety planning, crisis counseling, referrals and service coordination. Long term follow up is essential in some cases to avoid revictimization.

Watch out for elder abuse in your neighborhood. Studies indicate that 1 in 10 elders is abused, neglected, exploited, scammed, isolated or threatened. Allen County should be reporting 1,000 cases of elder abuse per year. Putnam County should be reporting 300. Only 10% of that is reported.
