- a. Victim Impact Panel Volunteer - Share your story as a victim to sensitize offenders, high school students and justice officials about the personal tragedy and trauma of criminal behavior. Your story can change people's lives and keep this crime from happening to someone else.
- b. On Call Volunteer - Respond to crisis calls, primarily domestic violence and sexual assault, after work hours. Your main responsibility is to offer support, information, and options. You will be asked to be on-call one week every one to two months.
- c. Victim Ministry Volunteer - Provide victims with Christian compassion and crisis intervention by phone or in person.
- d. Safe Home Volunteer - Provide a supportive, confidential, and safe environment for domestic violence victims and their children. An average stay is 3 to 10 days.
- e. Babysitting during court hearings, support group meetings, etc.
- f. Transportation for court hearings, appointments, etc.
- g. Office Assistance: clerical, bookkeeping filing, photocopying, etc.
- h. House keeping for Crime Victim Services: cleaning, sweeping, plant care, etc.
- i. Fund raising: organizing, mailings, phone calls, etc.
- j. Attend Crime Victim Services booth at mall, fairgrounds, etc.
- k. Special projects: bulk mailings, newsletter, etc.
